**INSTRUCTIONS FOR BLOOD COLLECTION AT
NEWYORK-PRESBYTERIAN HOSPITAL/WEILL CORNELL MEDICAL CENTER
COAGULATION LABORATORY**

Sophisticated, complex blood tests are not done adequately or at all by conventional commercial laboratories and therefore need to be performed by a lab that specializes in these kinds of tests. The NYPH Coagulation Laboratory requires a fresh blood sample. The technicians are specially trained to do complex, hands-on testing.

You may consume water, black coffee or tea without milk or sugar the day of the collection but nothing else except your usual medications.

Location: The C.V. Starr Pavilion is located on East 70th Street between York Avenue and the East River. The entrance to the Starr Pavilion is on the south side of East 70th Street under the overpass. The NYHL Patient Service Center (K-09) is located on the ground floor of the C.V. Starr Pavilion. Upon entering the lobby, go to the right. Pass the security desk/podium (at the entrance) and the sitting area on the right. After the vending machines, make a left turn. The NYHL Patient Service Center (K-09) is the second room on the right side of the hallway. Let the receptionist know that you have arrived, and a technologist will be with you shortly.

By Train: Take the #6 subway (Lexington Avenue Line) to the 68th Street station. Walk north to East 70th Street and make a right going east (toward Third Avenue). There is also the M66 bus at 68th Street and Lexington Avenue which will take you to York Avenue and 68th Street. Then make a left and walk north to 70th Street. Turn right onto 70th Street. The New York-Presbyterian Hospital C.V. Starr Pavilion entrance is the first doorway on the south side of the street.
